The 2nd International Virtual Talent Show, "We Are The World" hosted by Shu Ren Education and Potomac Chinese School is now open for registration. In 2020, the epidemic of COVID-19 had a huge impact and made tremendous changes to our lives. It has been said that: "The virtual platform has always been our dream. Now the epidemic has advanced our dream into reality." With the development of numerous cloud activities, virtual platforms rapidly developed in the education and entertainment fields. With the effort of group volunteers, we produced a virtual talent show, "We Are The World 2020." It was amazing to see all the talent from performances on pogo sticks to magic shows, from performances on musical instruments to dancing, from poetry reading to Rubik's cubes brought onto the virtual stage! We know that behind each performance there was one thing in common: passion!

Again, we are calling all singers, dancers, comedians, and anyone with a special talent to show us what you've got and join the virtual stage! Please review the details of the virtual talent show 2021 competition below.



- 1. The age of individual participants is limited to 3 to 18 year old.
- 2. If the individual acts with their family members or friends, there must be one main participant that meets the age requirement of 3 to 18. The total number of participants in any group is limited to 10.



- **First Place**, one winner will receive a prize of \$100.00
- **Second Place**, two winners will receive a prize of \$50.00



- **Third Place**, three winners will receive a prize of \$ 30.00
- **Honorable Mention**: 10 individuals who receive honorable mention will receive a 10% discount voucher for one session of a course at the Potomac Chinese School.

The top 15-20 videos will be included in a compilation video. The video will be released to the U.S social media for public fundraising. All donations will be sent to the American Red Cross for COVID-19 research.

In addition, the top 10 winners will be selected to join the Shu Ren Education Performing Arts Team participating in rehearsals and a live talent show in 2022. The American Chinese School at the Rockville campus will offer the top 10 winners a 10% discount voucher for one session of a course in the fall of 2021.



- 1. Suggested acts: dance, singing a song, beat box, musical instruments, magic acts, drama, comedy, slam-poetry reading, story telling, Yo-Yo tricks etc., ... It is your choice •
- 2. Video length and format: MP4 format is preferred for the videos. The length should not exceed four minutes. The registration form is required with the submission of the video. Language: English or Chinese only if a language is used during the performance.
- 3. The participant' name, age, location (country and city where the video is recorded), and title of the performance are required at the beginning of video. The video without the introduction may not be eligible for any awards.
